

Recently, it was brought to the Board's attention that a Satellite Dish company installed a dish on a new homeowner's Villa and in doing so, cut large tree branches to obtain the necessary signal.

Please be reminded that all plant material in the common area of our community is the responsibility of the HOA and our Landscaping Company, Caretaker. No homeowner nor contractor performing work at a homeowner's residence has the authority to alter any of our plant material.

At present, lawn maintenance and bush trimming is being performed on Thursdays and Fridays. The lawn maintenance crew is not equipped to deal with our trees. Caretaker has a separate crew and equipment for tree trimming.

In future, should a homeowner have a satellite installation scheduled and the company indicates that they need to remove tree limbs in order to provide the service, the homeowner shall contact our Community Manager for the appropriate action.
